Northmont Band Boosters 2018 Marching Band Financial & BSE Agreement (FA)

Membership in the Northmont Marching Band (which includes all playing members, color guard, percussion and front ensemble) requires both a financial and work (BSE) commitment from parents/guardians and student members. Without this two-tiered approach, Northmont Band Boosters would not be able to finance Marching Band activities, as Northmont City Schools provides only limited financial support to the program.

2018 MARCHING BAND PARTICIPATION FEES - \$670

March 6, 2018	Begin accepting registrations – 1 st payment is due at the time of registration, as well as the signed financial agreement.
April 10, 2018	Payment 1 of 5 (\$130) due the second Tuesday of April.
May 8, 2018	Payment 2 of 5 (\$135) due the second Tuesday of May.
June 12, 2018	Payment 3 of 5 (\$135) due the second Tuesday of June.
July 10, 2018	Payment 4 of 5 (\$135) due the second Tuesday of July. (There will be NO refunds after this date!)
August 14, 2018	Payment 5 of 5 (\$135) due the second Tuesday of August.

If you have participated in SCRIP or fundraisers, credit from those events which appear in your student's account will automatically be applied against current fees owed. If the credit is less than current fees owed, you will owe the difference at the time of registration.

Check if either or both apply:

- Payment Agreement information requested
 Financial Relief application requested
 - Any BSE buyouts (\$75 each) must be requested and approved in advance by the Booster President by August 14, 2018.
 - A booster may arrange for someone else to work BSE's for their student. Any agreement is the responsibility of the parties involved and no-shows will be subject to the standard \$75 surcharge.

2018 Marching Band Fees cover:

- 2018 show shirt ,BOA Regional patch, 2018
 MSBA Championship patch, 2018 show patch
- Competition entry fees
- Supplies, equipment and repairs to NBB owned equipment
- Bus transportation and some meals for BOA Regional, bus transportation to local shows
- Uniform cleaning and maintenance
- Color Guard costume (remains property of the marching band and must be turned in unless the student has made prior arrangements to purchase the costume.)

- Instrumentalist uniform shoes 1st year and as needed
- Musician gloves (2 pair)
- Color guard shoes (1 pair) and gloves (2 pair)

Out of Pocket (or Out of Account, if funds are available

- Color guard equipment and implements (white electrical tape, rifles) (\$5,\$40 approx)
- Color guard wind suit (approx. \$90) 1st year and as needed
- Percussion sticks/mallets not provided by the NBB, hybrid reed for all reed instruments, and other miscellaneous items

The following payment methods are available:

Option #1: Pay at Booster meetings by check, money order.

Option #2: Mail check or money order payable to NBB with student's name on memo line to: Northmont Band Boosters, P.O. Box 42, Englewood, OH 45322

(Returned checks for insufficient funds or closed accounts will be subject to a \$25 charge for processing)

Option #3: Pay using Charms CC option (link within Charms. (There is an additional 1.95% charge for this option which is applied at the time of the payment.)

Please do not give payments to the band or quard directors or staff!!!

BSE Requirement:

The NBB utilizes a two-tiered approach to finance the various Northmont Band Programs. One tier is through fees, which can be offset by a variety of fundraising opportunities offered throughout the year. The second tier is through **Booster Supported Events (BSEs)**, which requires a sweat equity/work commitment by Booster members and students to supplement the Booster organization's General Fund as a whole and reduce out-of-pocket fees. For example, the Northmont Band Boosters are contracted with the Athletic Department to run the concession stand for <u>all</u> Good Samaritan stadium events. In addition, there are several other BSE events where the Booster members are needed to volunteer their time to work shifts so that the Booster organization earns needed funding. For those Booster members who have challenges participating in the BSEs, we would encourage you to enlist the support of other family members or friends to work the BSEs or contact a Booster board member to discuss options.

Marching Band Booster Supported Events (BSEs) Requirements (May 1, 2018 thru April 30, 2019)

Each family, regardless of number of students, is <u>required</u> to fulfill ALL of the following BSEs, <u>plus an additional</u> two (2) events for each additional student (families with siblings in the band) from the Miscellaneous BSEs. If these BSEs are not fulfilled, a \$75 surcharge per BSE will be applied to your student's account)

Marching Band Student BSE Requirements:

<u>Each student</u> must work two (2) Student BSEs for the 2018 Marching Band season (in addition to the family BSEs listed previously) - <u>all unworked student BSEs will be charged \$75</u>:

- One (1) Event choose from JV/Freshman/Middle School football, track or soccer concessions; Mattress Sale, Spring Flower Sale pick-up, Breakfast with Santa, MEPA WinterGuard Show
- One (1) Car Wash each class has a car wash scheduled for a separate Saturday in June or July. In order to fulfill this requirement, students may work a different class car wash.

NOTE: Student BSEs DO NOT earn monetary credit toward their account.

Academic Eligibility

Students must be passing 5 qualifying classes to be eligible to participate in the marching band program. Eligibility during the first quarter (i.e. start of band season) will be based on 4th quarter grades from previous year.

SUMMARY:

In order for your student to participate in marching band you are making a commitment to the preceding fee schedule and BSE requirements. You agree that any family obligations that hinder your ability to make that commitment will be discussed in writing and in advance with the Booster President before the beginning of the season if any adjustments are to be made.

Communication is vital to the success of the band program and is crucial for those leads in any fundraising actions have adequate time to prepare for the staffing level changed they may experience.
