FINANCIAL AGREEMENT

The Financial Agreement outlines Band Fees, Band Fee Payment Schedule, clarifies BSE's and fundraising opportunities, and explains what the money is used for. It serves as a contract and signifies the student's and guardian's commitment to the Marching Band program.

BOOSTER SUPPORT EVENT (BSE)

BSE's are a form of sweat equity. There are several fundraising opportunities in which we need workers to fill positions to make the events successful. Examples include working Dragons games, flower sale pickup, sub sales, etc. The students account is credited a dollar value for each event. There is a minimum requirement for BSE's to ensure success of the events. *Failure to meet the minimum requirement will result in a charge to the student's account.*
